Student Testimonial

The consequences of my pro-Palestine advocacy have been swift and severe. As a safety marshal at a protest against the bombing of Al-Shifa hospital, I was doxxed by Zionist students, leading to my information being spread to far-right media. I have endured relentless death threats, lost my summer law firm offer and its accompanying diversity scholarship. This ordeal has set me back at least \$115,000 in lost income and legal fees, an overwhelming burden for my working-class family.

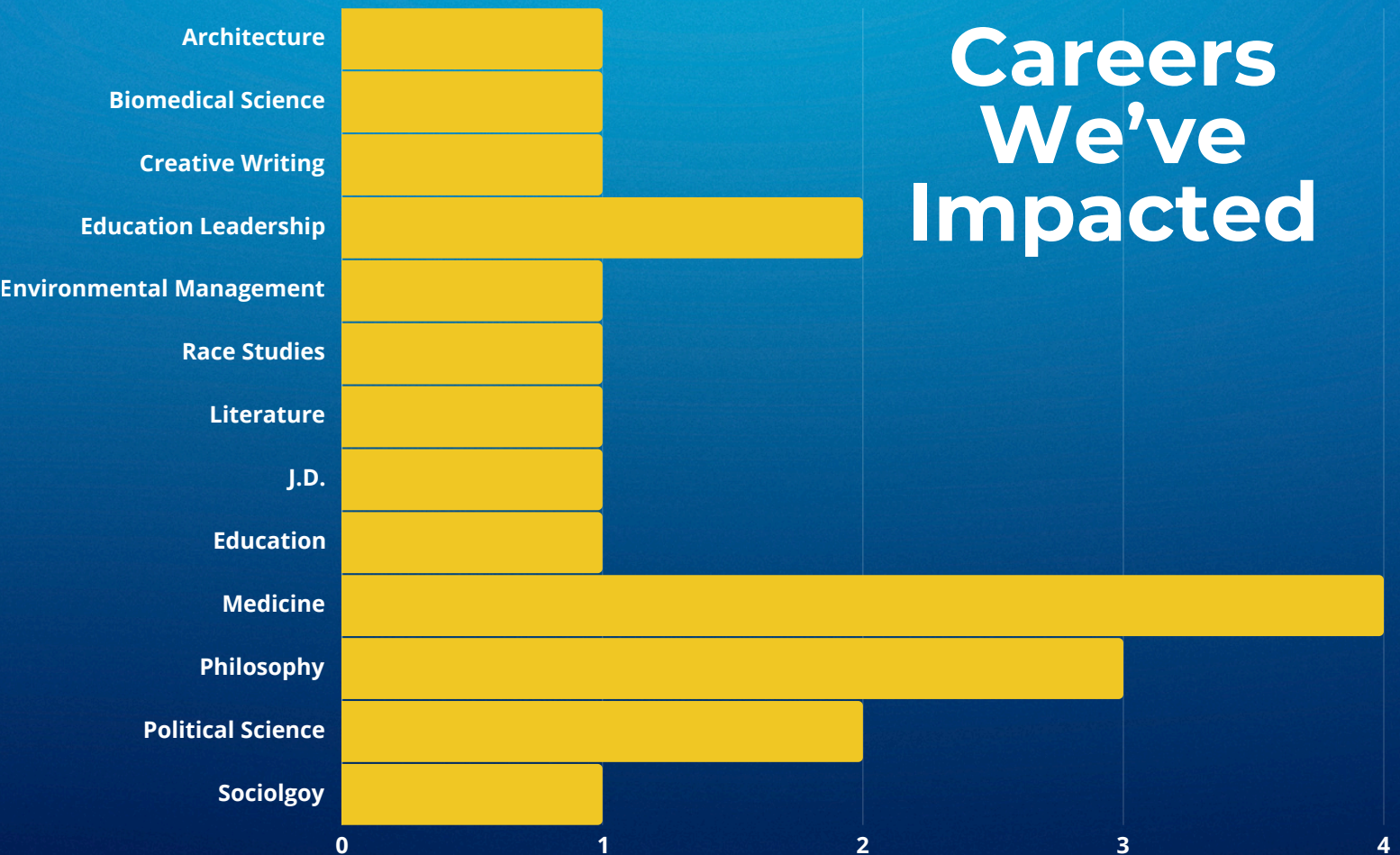
